▶ **Rachmat Budiman, Indonesian citizen, 66 years old, resides in Jakarta. He obtained a Bachelor of Law degree from the University of Indonesia in 1985. He completed diplomatic training at the Foreign Service Training School (Sekdilu) and the Senior Foreign Service Leadership School (Sesparlu).**

#### Brief Work Experience

With a professional background as a diplomat, he has served in The Hague (the Netherlands), Perth (Australia), Vienna (Austria) for two terms, New York (United States of America), and Bangkok (Thailand). He has extensive experience in implementing Indonesia's foreign policy (1986–2026), including handling issues of economic, social, and cultural cooperation, educational cooperation, maritime affairs, negotiations on Indonesia's territorial boundaries with neighboring countries, human rights, cooperation on the peaceful uses of nuclear energy, cooperation in combating the abuse of narcotics, psychotropic substances, other addictive substances, and transnational crime.

As a career diplomat, he has participated in various bilateral, regional, and multilateral meetings both as a Member and as Head of Delegation of the Republic of Indonesia, including as one of Indonesia's negotiators in boundary negotiations between the Republic of Indonesia and neighboring countries, as well as in the establishment of AICHR (ASEAN Intergovernmental Commission on Human Rights). In addition, he has experience chairing various multilateral meetings, including serving as President of the Conference of the Parties to the United Nations Convention against Transnational Organized Crime

He also has domestic experience, including serving as Secretary of the Directorate General of Information and Public Diplomacy, Director of Political, Security, and Territorial Treaties, and Inspector General of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs. His overseas assignments include serving as Ambassador of the Republic of Indonesia to the Republic of Austria and the Republic of Slovenia, concurrently Permanent Representative of the Republic of Indonesia to UNIDO, IAEA, CTBTO, OPEC, the OPEC Fund, and the United Nations Offices in Vienna (2012–2017), and Ambassador of the Republic of Indonesia to the Kingdom of Thailand, concurrently Permanent Representative of the Republic of Indonesia to UN-ESCAP (2020–2026)
